Oran R-3 School District On-Campus Learning Guidelines

Oran R-3 Schools will provide traditional, in-person/on-campus high-quality instruction (whole class, small groups, and individual) for students during the 2021-2022 school year. The guidelines below will be followed to ensure the safety of all students and staff.

Parents

If your child feels ill, answer the following questions. If the answer to any of these questions is yes, the student should stay home.

- Is your child's temperature 100 degrees or higher?
- Has your child had a fever within the last three days?
- Has your child experienced any respiratory symptoms?
- Has your child experienced any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, chills, muscle pain, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting, diarrhea, or sore throat)?

District

The Oran R-3 School District staff members will:

- Screen themselves prior to arriving at school using COVID-19 screening guidelines
- Monitor social distancing
- Arrange frequent handwashing opportunities
- Arrange desks to allow for social distancing
- Provide hand sanitizer dispensers in every classroom, hallway, and commons area
- Provide touchless water bottle filling stations in each building
- Monitor students to ensure school supplies are not shared
- Encourage students to wear masks when social distancing is not possible
- Require K-12 students using school district transportation to wear a mask (per federal mandate)
- Provide isolation rooms in each building for any student or staff with COVID-19 symptoms
- Provide additional cleaning and sanitization
